INSTRUCTIONS

This document requires completion and submission with the **most recent report card** and a **current transcript** (both translated into English and notairized), a **recent photograph** as well as **proof of proficiency in the English language** (a combination of IELTS score of 4.5 or higher or enrolmnet in an English medium school).

Once a completed application is received, the admissions team may contact you to arrange for a Google Hangouts, Zoom meeting, or WeChat video call with the applicant. These conversations provide opportunities for students to learn more about The Study Academy and for the school to assess student "fit" with our school culture. After the video call, the school will arrange for the applicant to complete a placement assessment.

Offers of admission will be made twice throughout the school year for applicants who apply before the relevant deadlines. If spaces remain, applicants will be considered on an ongoing basis after the equal consideration deadline. Please note the following key dates:

FEE SCHEDULE NOTES

Payment Information

- All fees are quoted in Canadian funds, effective October 1, 2019.
- The Study Academy accepts payment by personal cheque, money order, bank draft, e-Transfer (to <u>admin@thestudyacademy.ca</u>), certified cheque, and wire transfer (requires receipt submission).
- Payments received in currencies other than Canadian Dollars will be converted into CAD at the exchange rate determined by The Study Academy on the day the money is deposited.
- Payment Option 1 (standard payment) requires post-dated cheques be submitted with registration.
- Part-time enrolment requires payment in full prior to the start of class.

Tuition Fee Refund Policy

- Students who are required to leave the school because of behavioural reasons (i.e., expulsion or indefinite suspension) are not eligible for any refund of Tuition Fees.
- The non-refundable deposit of \$8,000 (due on registration) is not refundable under any circumstance.
- Part-Time Tuition Fees are not refundable under any circumstance.
- If the custodial parent(s)/guardian(s) choose(s) to withdraw their child(ren) enrolled in full-time from The Study Academy, full-time tuition fees may be refunded as follows:
 - Prior to October 15, 75% of the refundable portion of the Tuition Fees may be refunded.
 - Prior to December 31, 50% of the refundable portion of the Tuition Fees may be refunded.
 - After December 31, Tuition Fees are entirely non-refundable.
- In order to be considered for the refund, the fully completed withdrawal form must be received by email on or before the relevant cut-off date listed in this policy.
- Custodial parent(s)/guardian(s) may withdraw their child(ren) from The Study Academy by completing and filing out a form (School Withdrawal.pdf), which may be requested from and submitted to <u>admissions@thestudyacademy.ca</u>.
- Refunds are available by application (Tuition Refund Request.pdf), the form for which may be requested from and submitted to <u>admissions@thestudyacademy.ca</u>.

Extra Costs

- Textbooks are not included in the Tuition Fees. The cost of textbooks will vary depending on the courses a student is enrolled in. Upper School students should budget \$700-\$900 and Lower School students \$0-\$200. Textbooks are available at Alpha Textbooks via pick-up or online order (alphatextbooks.com).
- Field trips, school activities, and yearbooks are included in the Tuition Fees. However, school clothing (TSA Gear), our Inspire Week community service trip (<u>thestudyacademy.ca/discover/student-life/#inspire-week</u>, optional attendance for Upper School students) and other overnight trips are not. Overnight trips are optional, may include international travel, and may cost as much as \$3,000.
