
Illness, Closure, and Disclosure Schedule

Mark IX (January 13, 2022)

School Closures and Disclosures:

- The School (or subgroups such as classes or cohorts) will transition to online learning in cases where adequate supervision is not available due to isolations and as a measure to slow the spread of COVID-19 at school in the case of presumed outbreaks
- All active Code 2 cases will be reported through the Illness Disclosure tool (families may choose to access)



Notes:

- * Predictive COVID-19 symptoms (and signs) include a positive result on a Rapid Antigen test or PCR test; cough; decrease or loss of taste or smell; fever or chills; and shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Less predictive COVID-19 symptoms (and signs) include extreme fatigue, malaise, or muscle ache; headache; runny or stuffy nose; sore throat or pain swallowing; and nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- ** Direct contact involves being near (< 2m) someone for more than 15 minutes and may include family members, friends, classmates, and notifications through COVID Alert
- *** A person presumed to have COVID-19 is experiencing illness (as described above), has received medical advise to get tested, or is awaiting COVID-19 test results
- **** A fully vaccinated individual has received two doses of approved COVID-19 vaccines and has completed a two week period to follow

In addition to these isolation protocols, individuals may also need to isolate based on travel requirements from the Federal Government or by direction from public health
